## Professor Srikanta Chatterjee

Talk Title: The Next Global Superpower: Is India in the Running?

Professor Chatterjee is an Emeritus Professor of Economics in the School of Economics and Finance, Massey University, New Zealand. Prior to his retirement in 2011, Professor Chatterjee had held a Personal Chair in economics in this department since 1995. His research and publications have covered a wide variety of areas including international economics, applied demand analysis, income distribution and inequality, comparative perspectives on the Indian and Chinese economic performance, issues of India's food and nutrition security, economic performance of the Asia-Pacific economies and the economic reform of New Zealand.

Professor Chatterjee has been involved in consulting work both in the private sector and government. In 2000, a wide-ranging tax review was launched by the New Zealand government. In the six-member group appointed by the Finance Minister, Professor Chatterjee was one of the two economists. In 2012, Professor Chatterjee was invited by the Charles Sturt University in Sydney, Australia to participate in an Australian government sponsored programme to impart research training to a group of senior academics from the People's Republic of China.

Professor Chatterjee has held visiting positions in universities and research institutions in a number of other countries. After retirement, he has widened his studies and research to include international relations, security, geopolitics and geo-economics, political and cultural history of India and the lives and works of eminent personalities of the Indian renaissance. He has been addressing lectures and seminars and publishing in these subjects. Apart from publishing a number of articles in top-ranked journals, he contributed in several books by authoring chapters.
